

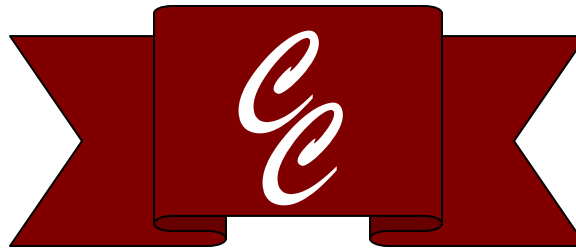
Our Goals

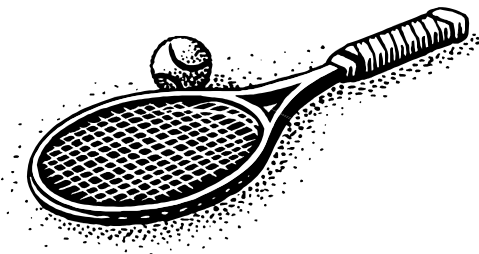
