8490-R Extracurricular Activities

8490-R-4

### Attendance

All students involved in extra-curricular activities are expected to be in attendance the entire school day (the full 6-class period day) in order to participate in that day's practice, contest, or event.

An extra-curricular activity student, after signing out of school due to illness, will not be allowed to return after school to participate in a practice sessions, competitions, or events.

An extra-curricular activity student who is suspended from regular classroom attendance for 3 class hours or longer (this applies to both in-school and out-of-school suspension) may not practice or participate in an interscholastic contest or event during said suspension.

Exceptions to the attendance requirement must be approved by the Office of the Coordinator of Extra-curricular Activities prior to participation.

“Exception” delineation:

1. Funeral
2. Documented medical appointments (with a note)
3. Pre-arranged college visitations
4. School-related absences
5. Acts of God
6. Extenuating Circumstances as determined by the Administration
